## MATRIMONY

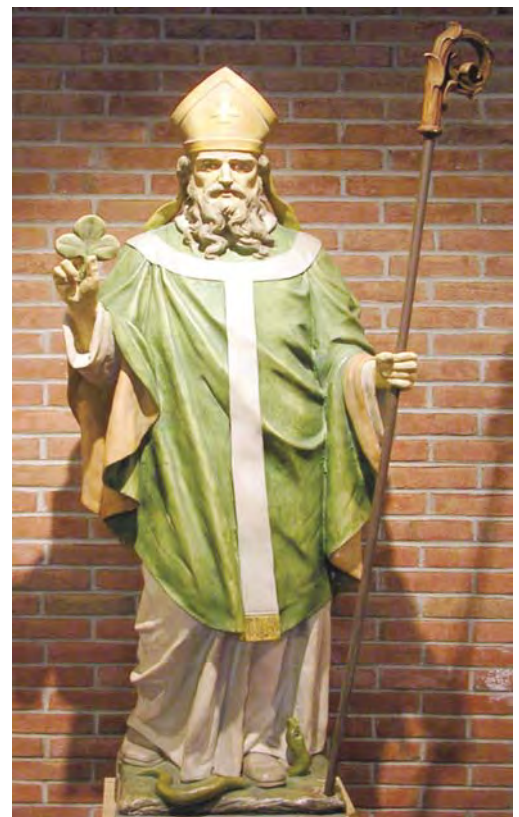
