MATRIMONY

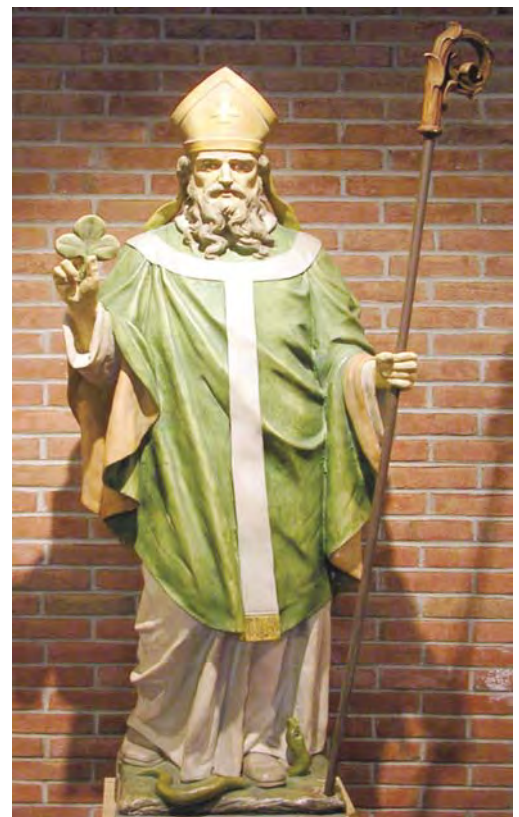

FUTURE BLESSINGS

Last week, I reflected on the blessings of my own priesthood over the past 21 years. I have to say thank you for the many good wishes I received. This week it is time to talk about the future blessings of the ministry that are connected with St. Patrick's Parish.

First, the seminarian who was with us last summer, Matthew Reiman, will be ordained to the priesthood next week, on May 23rd. Fr. Reiman will celebrate the 12:30 Mass here at St. Patrick's on May 31st, concelebrated by all our priests. Whether we all realize it or not, we have played an important part in Matt's formation, and he is part of our parish community.

Next, we have a new seminarian to "train up" this summer. I hope that you all will have the opportunity to meet Eddie Lazzari, who is from Orange County. Eddie just finished his first year at St. Joseph's Seminary and will be with us until the beginning of July. He will be assisting at Mass and at the school, giving some reflections at daily Mass, helping with wakes and burials, and generally doing anything that will help him get a feel for parish life. Eddie is a fine young man. Please make him feel welcome at St. Patrick's.

Third, we have a homegrown vocation. Mr. Anthony Marcella, who many of you know from his organ playing, his singing, and his serving at Mass over the past few years, will be graduating from Fordham University and finishing his time at the Cathedral Residence of the Immaculate Conception in Douglaston, Queens. God willing, Anthony will move on to St. Joseph's Seminary in the fall and continue his path to priesthood.

In addition, we have one man who will be ordained a deacon in just a few weeks, another who is halfway through, and a third who is applying for admission to the program. We will be celebrating with Richard Scheibe on June 20th, and waiting a couple more years for Ed Benvenga. Our other candidate will be made known after his acceptance.

Lastly, we have a young man who has applied for admission to the seminary system, and several more who are on the cusp of accepting the call of Christ to serve his Church. We even have two young men who will be involved in the High School program for those who believe that they may have a vocation.

All in all, I would say that St. Patrick's is doing its part to foster vocations to the priesthood. Ever since I was a little boy, the people of St. Patrick's have loved their priests, and they continue to do so. Please continue to pray for all these men, for the priests that serve you, and for vocations to the priesthood and religious life.
