MATRIMONY

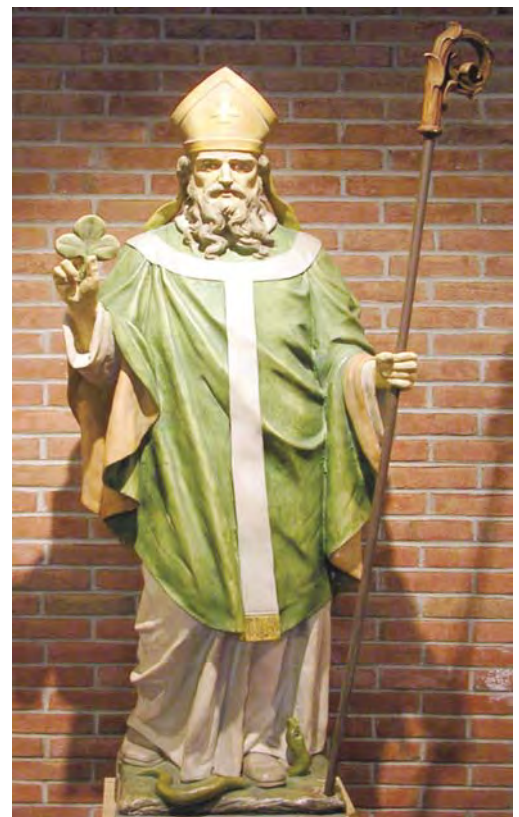
