From the desk of Fr. Tom Kreiser

LIFE – PART TWO

Last week, my column was devoted principally to the issue of life in the womb – preborn life. Because this is the most vulnerable, it seems to me that we have to do all in our power to protect innocent children from destruction. But there are many other life issues that need to be in our heads as well. I would like to mention just a few of them.

- 1) The elderly – sometimes those who have reached a certain age in our society can be forgotten, or worse yet, ignored. They have a wisdom that we cannot forget or ignore, and they are in need of our care. This is a real obligation, not something we do when we feel like it. If these people are our parents, we have an even greater obligation to make sure that they are cared for. A visit, a kind word, a small gift, or just sitting and listening to them can be enough to make their day and give them a lift.
- 2) The disabled – those who are in some way disabled can also often be overlooked by our society. They too have a great deal to share with us. They show us that suffering can be redemptive and that even when we are not 100% capable of doing everything, we are certainly still people in need of love and attention.
- 3) The prisoner – we don't often like to think of the prisoner as someone that we must love. After all, they have violated the rules of society. But Jesus tells us that we do indeed have an obligation to them. If nothing else, we can pray for them. If possible, we can perhaps visit or write to them, and when they have finished their sentence, we can offer them an opportunity to rebuild their lives.
- 4) The poor – we sometimes don't realize that one of our prejudices can be economic. Sometimes we treat those who are poor as if they have done something wrong or are not worthy of the blessings that we share. Pope Francis has certainly made us aware of the plight of the poor, and the fact that we have so much compared to others doesn't make us better than them, it simply makes us blessed. What we have, we have been given to share. Let's make sure that we are doing our part to take care of the poor.
- 5) The addict – there are so many in our society who suffer from addiction. Drugs, alcohol, sex, food, gambling, etc. etc. etc. are all things that can diminish the personhood of an individual. While it is true that those who are addicted must want to accept the help that we offer, it doesn't excuse us from doing the offering. We must pray for those who are addicted, and encourage them to work to overcome their affliction. Addiction is a disease, as real as cancer or diabetes, and we can help to supply the medicine that is needed by those who suffer from it.

These are just a few of the groups that need our love and support. If we remember that life is a precious gift that is given to us, and to everyone else, we will do all that is in our power to make each life count. Dr. Seuss once said, "A person's a person, no matter how small." Or how fragile, or how broken, or how in need. Let's make everyone count.
