WHAT CAN I DO?

One part of the moral teaching of the Catholic Church that is rarely discussed is the concept of social sin. What is social sin? It is the sin that occurs when structures and policies, laws and mores of a society turn away from what God would have us do. The classic example in the Sacred Scripture is the story of the Tower of Babel. The entire society decided that they wanted to “reach to the heavens,” in essence to be God. God’s retaliation was to confuse the speech of the people so that they could not understand each other.

Despite whether the story itself is historically accurate, we learn from it that there are times when society goes astray from God’s will. In our own society, the slaughter of the innocent in the womb, the attack on traditional marriage, and the movement to legalize assisted suicide and euthanasia are but a few examples of social sin. There are also some structures within our society that marginalize people and do them injustice. These too are an example of social sin.

The task of overcoming these sins might seem to be impossible or at least overwhelming. What can one person do to change an entire society? Does my voice count for anything? I am just a single entity among so many, and there is so much that has to be changed. So what do I do?

The most important thing that we can do is to attack these things with our spiritual life. We must pray, and we must offer penance and sacrifice, particularly perhaps during Lent, for the conversion of our society. The great Saints tell us that offering things up in reparation for the sins of the world has great value. The sacrifices we offer and the penances we do during Lent should not be just for ourselves, but also for the world. God’s grace can do remarkable things, and that grace is provided, in part, through our penance and sacrifice. “Giving something up” for Lent is a great beginning, but it is only a beginning. Patience, tolerance, and temperance should be the fruit of our sacrifices. Penance and sacrifice will help us to learn these things; they will help us to do things like avoiding gossip and being judgmental, resisting anger and fits of temper, and developing an attitude of kindness and justice to all. And our sacrifices will provide the opportunity for others to be graced by God, perhaps to change their attitudes or behaviors. We can begin to change the world by changing ourselves.

In addition, we can get involved in the processes that will change unjust laws and structures. The pro-life movement always needs advocates, and that means for all lives: born and pre-born, old and young, healthy and sick. We can work for social justice; as well as sharing our time, talent and resources with others.

At the end of all that, we might still feel that my little attempts, my sacrifices, my penance, my work for justice, has accomplished nothing. Don’t let the devil discourage you. We will never know in this life exactly how much grace we have gained for ourselves and for others. We may not be able to change the world, but if each of us does his or her part, the grace of God will make a difference.

There is one more key – don’t be complacent. We can get into a rut of doing (or not doing) things. Constantly look for little ways to sacrifice, to do penance, and to offer yourself. Let God do the rest. He will take care of the conversions.
