If you haven’t been to Confession in the last month, year, or longer, maybe it’s time to come back to Our Lord’s special loving embrace found in this Sacrament. You will be amazed at how much more merciful you can be when you allow God’s Mercy into your life.

## Tellin' It Like It Is

It is hard to believe that March begins tomorrow. The first two months of the year seem to have flown by. With a new month, in this Year of Mercy, we focus on a new Work of Mercy to practice. For the month of March, we will be concentrating on Admonishing the Sinner.

The first thing I did was to look up the word admonish in the dictionary. The first definition is “to warn gently.” And that is exactly what we mean in this Work of Mercy. We need to gently remind those around us who are consistently committing sin that there are consequences for it.

This can be a very difficult thing to do. We may immediately be accused of being “holier than thou” type of people, and the fear of that might make us leery to actually warn someone. But let’s look for a minute at how Jesus did it.

Every time Jesus encountered a sinner, especially a big sinner, he focused on the sin and on the people who stood in judgment. “Let the one among you who is without sin cast the first stone,” Jesus said to the crowd about the woman caught in adultery. Nobody cast a stone. But Jesus doesn’t “let her off the hook.” He reminds her that she must “go and sin no more.”

This is the type of attitude we must have when we are admonishing the sinner. Those who are living a lifestyle contrary to their faith are risking their chance to go to heaven. That is the reality of it. We would like to think that all people go to heaven because they are “good people,” but Jesus is clear that this is not the case. To Admonish the Sinner is an Act of Mercy precisely because it can bring a person back to the sincere practice of their faith.

It isn’t easy, that is for sure. But it is possible. In a gentle way, we can remind a person that sinful behavior risks us going to eternal punishment. Not with a wag of the head and a “tut, tut,” but rather with a reminder that Jesus loves them and wants them to be the best people that they can be, and that their behavior or lifestyle is not in accord with what Jesus teaches us in the Scriptures and in the Church.

One of the most important things that we must remember when we admonish others is that we ourselves are sinners. If we approach this work of mercy in a way that pretends that we are not sinners, we deserve the “holier than thou” speech. But if we are humble in the way we approach it, we very well might get the person to think about what they are doing. And if we don’t, that is the problem of the sinner, not of us. As long as we are attempting to do the right thing, we have done our job.

We also have to be prepared to take heat for admonishing the sinner. They might not wish to talk to us any more, or they might distance themselves from us. This, again, might keep us from speaking out in the first place. But it shouldn’t. When we “tell it like it is,” we offer the person a chance for conversion and a return to friendship with Jesus. If they are carrying on a lifestyle that is contrary to the commandments, they are not the best that they can be, and run the risk of losing their soul. Love means that we sometimes have to be tough, and that is what Admonishing the Sinner is all about.
