Do you want Jesus to transform your heart?



*Receiving Holy Communion will change your life in ways you cannot imagine if afterward you take a moment and **PRAY**.*

- P PAUSE** Most importantly, take a few moments and enjoy Jesus being in your heart. *Just listen.*
- R REFLECT** Thank God for the many blessings in your life, most especially the Eucharist.
- A ASK** Ask for Jesus' help to bring God glory, to do acts of love for Him and to avoid deliberate sin.
- Y YES** Say YES to bring Him to people in your life and to YEARN to receive Him again.

We should always remember that Jesus remains physically present in us for 10 to 15 minutes after we receive Him in Holy Communion. The Saints recognized that this was as close to Heaven as anyone can be on Earth. They longed to receive Holy Communion as often as possible so that they could feel those special moments in which they knew that Jesus – body, soul and divinity – resided in their hearts.

*Let's all try to take time to **PRAY** after receiving Holy Communion so that we can allow Jesus to bring us the joy and happiness that comes from being united to Him.*
