



FATHERS

Today we celebrate Father's Day. I don't know about you, but I think that fathers have gotten a bad name in our society over the past years. So many of the sitcoms that we see on television portray dads as bumbling fools that don't really know what is going on. Moms hide things from them, and often they conspire with children to "put one over" on dad.

In my house growing up, my dad was not someone you "got something over" on. He was our helper, our protector, our "go-to" guy that could help to solve every problem. He worked together with my mom to raise strong, good, God-centered children (9 of them).

Fathers are meant to be an image of God the Father. God the Father is our helper, our protector, our "go-to" guy for everything. Dads imitate that. They are not perfect, but they try.

The best thing about my dad was that he taught me about my faith. Did you know that teaching children about faith in God, in Christ, and in the Church is the primary responsibility of parents? It is a greater priority than anything else in the life of a child. Parents are responsible for the soul of the child that God has given them. Of course, parents need to feed, clothe, house and educate their children, but guaranteeing their eternal life trumps everything.

I knew a family in my first parish. Their 13-year-old did not want to go to Mass one weekend, and, as 13 year olds are prone to do, he asked, "Why do I have to go to Mass?" The mom, not missing a beat, said, "because when I stand before God, I have to answer for your soul." What a great answer! Moms and dads need to think that way more often.

Dad taught me strength. Not physical strength, but an emotional and spiritual strength. He taught me that being a man didn't have anything to do with being able to beat other people up, or lifting weights, or prowess with women, but rather with compassion, kindness and dependence on God. Dad was the head of the household, but in a real way. He shared responsibility with my mom, and together they relied on divine power to guide them in being good parents.

Dad taught me how to be a father. That's right, a father. I don't have natural children, but I have spiritual children (thousands of them). Being a father means guiding, instructing, protecting, and occasionally correcting children. It means teaching children that spiritual well-being is the most important thing that we can spend time on. It means showing kindness, compassion and generosity. And although I am as imperfect as my own father, I try to be a good "dad" to the people of St. Patrick's.

In our world, there are many families that, for whatever reason, don't have a dad there full time. That doesn't mean that they can't be as positive an influence on their children as possible. Fathers can teach their children many things, even if they don't get to spend a great deal of time together. And most important of all, fathers can teach their children that a spiritual life, a life lived in God and with God, is the reason we are created.

To all the dads of our parish, Happy Father's Day. May God continue to bless you as you strive to raise your children.


