A Note from the Pastor's Desk

Dear Parishioners,

Hopefully, Lent is proving to be a prayerful time for you. Often enough, a busy schedule has a way of pushing Lent observances to the “back burner,” but if we make the extra effort, we can make time for prayer and even tiny sacrifices to help us prepare for Easter.

I want to mention in these notes that I will be speaking at all the Masses next weekend to ask for your help in reaching our parish goal for the 2017 Cardinal's Appeal. Many of you have already pledged or donated, but we are not yet at the halfway mark. Our goal is a lofty \$178,000.00 and, judging by the history here, I am certain we can reach the goal. I thank you if you have already given, and I ask you to consider pledging next weekend if you have not been able to commit yet. The Archdiocese does so much to help the parishes and all of the parishioners throughout the ten counties, so whatever we are able to do to support that work is worthy of our charity.

I am very much aware that you constantly receive many requests for your help, but certain requests hit closer to home than others. Donations for our parish and the Archdiocese are among the most necessary for our life of faith.

There are other needs that are also extremely worthy of our attention, and we priests have just recently become aware of an urgent need. One of our families in the parish is going through a very rough time. One year old Christian Dunn has been diagnosed with an extremely rare disease called Lamin related congenital muscular dystrophy. Little Christian is one of only 50 children in the world with this type of dystrophy. There is very little support for the family and even less research taking place and I believe we would all want to help Christian and his family as they face a debilitating disease and frightening future, near and far. If you would like to help Christian, you may donate to the St. Patrick's Good Samaritan Fund and put *Christian's Courage* in the Memo. I am certain that any assistance we can offer would be most appreciated by the Dunn family. First and foremost, we can offer our prayers and then any other possible help as well.
