MERCY ME – PART 2

We had a great start to the Year of Mercy. Quite a few people finished their consecration to Our Lady on December 8th, all the priests were busy for four hours hearing confessions this past Monday, and a good number of those who came to confession had been away from the Sacraments for quite a long time. That means that the Year of Mercy is already a success here at St. Patrick's. And we are just getting started.

As I write this on December 18th, we are preparing for a Holy Hour/Concert by Katy Feeney, renowned Catholic singer and harpist. Katy is going to present "The people of Advent." This is a way for us to remember how the world was prepared for the mercy of God poured out for us in Christ Jesus. Katy will return during Lent and the Easter season to continue the theme of God's mercy.

As I mentioned two weeks ago, the Year of Mercy needs to extend to us. It is wonderful for us to take advantage of God's mercy, but we must also be the extenders of mercy to others. That means offering forgiveness to those who have hurt us. This is, of course, not an easy thing to do, but if we search the Gospels, we find that it is one of the commands that Jesus gives us. We are to forgive as we are forgiven. We say it every day in the Our Father, the prayer given to us directly by Christ. He follows that up in the Gospel by saying, "As you forgive one another, so will your Heavenly Father forgive you." In fact, Jesus speaks about the need to forgive on several occasions, and he shows us the way to do it by forgiving even his torturers from the cross! If Jesus can do that, and He was the sinless Son of God, why can't we, who are sinners ourselves, forgive the shortcomings of others?

Don't get me wrong – it may not happen immediately. After all, some hurts are tremendously big. Broken promises, abusive relationships, etc. can be very hard to come to terms with, and yet, if we really want to live the Gospel to the fullest, we need to forgive those who have hurt us, even gravely.

We need also remember that forgiving doesn't immediately mean forgetting. Like a scar that happens after we suffer a wound, the memories of the hurt may linger. When these memories return, it is time to pray – for ourselves and for the person we have forgiven. God tells us that He forgives and forgets. While it may take a while for that to happen, we should try and do the same.

This week we have celebrated the coming of God as man, the beginning of the manifestation of God's mercy in human form. We also look forward to a brand new year. As we continue to mark these events, let us think long and hard about people we may need to forgive from the heart. Pray for the grace to do that, for if we ask God to grant us mercy, He will do it.
