From the desk of Fr. Tom Kreiser

COULD YOU NOT STAY WITH ME ONE HOUR?

It has been over 25 years since St. Patrick's Parish instituted extended Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament. I remember when I was home for summer break in the seminary and was working, I would stop in for a little while on my way home. There was always someone there, praying to the Lord in His physical presence, praying for the parish as well as for their own needs.

This week, we have had to suspend adoration because of a lack of adorers. That means that there just are not enough people who are making the time to come and pray with Jesus. You see, Jesus can't be left alone. It is sad that we have had to do this, but it gives us an opportunity to reset our adoration times, and remember what it is about.

Adoration means "to gaze lovingly" on Jesus and to pray to him, about anything. It can be about our personal needs, it can be for world peace, vocations, our parish, whatever. We can also pray in sorrow for our sins, in thanksgiving for the blessings we have been given, or we may just sit with Jesus quietly, enjoying His presence. Sometimes friendship is best expressed when no words are exchanged.

Anyone can come to adore. Individuals, groups, families – it doesn't matter. As long as there is always someone with Jesus, we are OK. And what it will do for you and for our parish is incredible. You can't believe how many graces you will receive just from spending an hour with Jesus once a week.

So here is the plan. The priests will preach about adoration this weekend, asking people to consider taking an hour. We will begin with Thursdays and Fridays, and when those are filled **with two adorers for each hour**, we will go backwards to Wednesdays, Tuesdays, and, if possible, Mondays. The Blessed Sacrament will be exposed from 9:30 AM until 9:00 PM. We really need to have two adorers for each hour, so that if one cannot make it, the hour will still be covered. Two adorers also helps with safety issues.

Please consider actually signing up for an hour. I know a good number of people come to Adoration but are not sure if they can commit to a specific time each week. I guarantee you, if you make the time for Jesus, He will make time for you. Pick an hour and tell the Lord you will stick to it. He asked the disciples in the garden for one hour, and now He is asking it of us. Let's not let our twenty-five-year-old practice end! The graces for you and for our parish will be monumental.



On another note, I will be the Spiritual Director for a pilgrimage trip to Israel next January. It is going to be a great trip, during which we will see all the holy sites where the Lord was born, lived, suffered and died for us.

There are brochures in the back of the Church outlining the itinerary and the cost. We will leave on January 16th and return on January 25th, 2017. The approximate cost per person is \$3,100.

I would love to have many, many parishioners and friends along with me on this once-in-a-lifetime experience. We will have daily Mass and prayer time, as well as an opportunity to get to know others and have some fun. Please pick up a brochure and consider coming along on this wonderful pilgrimage to the Holy Land.
